ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Application forms for admission to the teacher education program may be obtained from the Office of Student Services, N310 LC. The deadlines for applications to the secondary teacher education program are March 15 and October 15. **A limited number of applicants are accepted into the Chinese teacher education program, so meeting the minimum requirements listed below do not ensure admission.** Other criteria relevant to teaching success are also considered.

MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. A University of Iowa g.p.a. and cumulative g.p.a. of 2.70 at the time of admission to this program.
2. Completion of at least 40 semester hours of college credit.
3. Completion of a 10-hour volunteer practicum in a K-12 classroom setting.
4. Completion of the Praxis I exam.
5. Completion of 12 semester hours of course work in Chinese.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

1. Completion of all professional education requirements for teaching Chinese in grades 7-12.
2. Completion of a Chinese teaching major as defined by the College of Liberal Arts' Department of Asian Languages and Literature.
3. Maintenance of a University of Iowa g.p.a. and cumulative g.p.a. of 2.70 on all course work, a g.p.a. of 3.00 on all course work in Chinese or not less than a 2.70 in Chinese and verification of competency in oral communication by the Department of Asian Languages and Literature at the time of registration for student teaching and at the time of recommendation for licensure.
4. Approval by the designated College of Education advisor of all transfer credit or substitutions of courses for requirements listed.
5. At the time of application for student teaching, a completed copy of this program guide signed by the College of Education advisor should be attached to the licensure application.
6. Student must complete a minimum of 20 semester hours at this institution for The University of Iowa to recommend for licensure.
7. Completion of a college-level mathematics course (excluding 22M:1/2/3)
