The University of Iowa Child Protection Program collaborated with Turkish professionals to develop a training program on child abuse and neglect from 2002 to 2006 with the goals of increasing professional awareness and the number of multidisciplinary teams (MDT), regional collaborations, and assessed cases. This lecture will discuss the five year outcomes of this collaboration.

Dr. Resmiye Oral is the Clinical Director of the Child Protection Program and Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics. Her work is both local and global. She is currently working to establish a collaboration between St. Luke's Hospital Child Protection Center and the University of Iowa Children's Hospital Child Protection Program to provide child abuse services to remote areas of Iowa via telemedicine. She is also working with national and regional policy makers and child protection agencies to develop regional, interdisciplinary child abuse task forces and child advocacy centers in Turkey.
