Accessing the application

The application is a fillable PDF form. You must print the completed document and submit it to Study Abroad via email (teresa-kout@uiowa.edu). You can open and fill out the form using any free program, such as Acrobat Reader, that opens PDF forms.

Eligibility requirements

- Undergraduate, full-time, degree-seeking UI student in good academic standing
- Minimum 3.33 overall cumulative GPA with at least 12 semester hours earned by application deadline
- Application to an approved, academic-credit-granting study abroad program earning at least twelve (12) semester hours

Completing the application

Submit each of the following documents to the Study Abroad office by email (teresa-kout@uiowa.edu) by the application deadline:

- Application form.
- Statement of Proposed Study: On a separate sheet of paper, in 750 words or less, describe the study abroad program in which you intend to participate and/or the independent study project you are planning to undertake, and explain how you expect your time abroad to contribute to your academic and personal goals. *Be sure to include your name and UID in the upper-right corner of the page.*
- **Personal Profile:** Write a narrative description of yourself, explaining why you believe you are a strong candidate for a **merit**-based study abroad scholarship. This statement should deal with your personal history, family background, intellectual interests, educational achievements, cultural opportunities to which you have been exposed, and the ways in which these experiences have affected you. Include information about awards or recognition you have received, participation in extracurricular activities, and special interests and abilities. *Be sure to include your name and UID in the upperright corner of the page*.
- Unofficial Grade Report: This is available on MyUI (look for GRADES tile). Be sure to include your name and UID in the upper-right corner of the page.
- Submit the entire application packet via email (teresa-kout@uiowa.edu) by the application deadline. Incomplete application packets will NOT be accepted.
- **Two Letters of Recommendation:** Referees should know you well and be Professors and/or Teaching Assistants at the University of Iowa. There are two forms labeled "Request for Recommendation Letter" on Page 3 of this application. Be sure to ask your referees early to give them plenty of time to complete the recommendation and submit by email (teresa-kout@uiowa.edu) for inclusion with your scholarship application. *The Letters of Recommendation must be sent by the author of the letter via email (teresa-kout@uiowa.edu) for inclusion with the completed application.*

Deadlines

Check the deadlines posted on the Study Abroad web site (<u>http://international.uiowa.edu/study-abroad/funding</u>). Late applications will not be accepted. Please inform your referees of the deadline as all Letters of Recommendation must arrive prior to the published deadline.

Selection Process

After the deadline, all applications will be reviewed by the Study Abroad Scholarship Committee. At least three members will review each application independently. You will be notified of the outcome at the conclusion of the process. *Note: It may take several weeks. Please be patient!*

Confidentiality Statement

The UI requests this information for the purpose of making a recommendation concerning your application for a scholarship. This information will be shared with faculty committees at the University of Iowa and with administrators of the scholarship program. In addition, notices about recipients of UI-administered scholarship programs are often sent to hometown newspapers for publication.
