

### **Total Number of UI Students Studying Abroad**

For national Open Doors reporting, 1,227 University of Iowa students studied, worked, or conducted research abroad for credit between fall 2011 and summer 2012. Open Doors does not include international students who study abroad or students who were involved in traveling abroad for short-term conference travel, athletics, and programs aimed at recent graduates. In previous years, all of these categories of students were reported to Open Doors. This year they were not.


University of Iowa students studied, worked, or conducted research abroad for credit between fall 2011 and summer 2012 (including international students).

This represents a 5.6% increase from the previous year when 1,279 UI students participated in such activities.


- 978 UI undergraduate students participated in these activities abroad, a 12.5% increase from 2010-11 (869).
- 373 UI graduate students participated in these activities, a 9% decrease from 2010-11 (410).







#### **Academic Status**





### **Duration of Study**









Comparing the number of undergraduate degree candidates who studied abroad during 2011-12 (978) to the number of bachelor's degrees awarded by the UI during 2011-12 (4,351) indicates that approximately 22% of the current graduating class studied abroad during their stay at the UI.




#### Gender

#### Percentage of UI undergraduate students that are female



#### Percentage of UI grad & professional students that are female









### **Ethnicity**

Information on ethnicity was reported by 95% (932) of the undergraduate U.S. student participants. 16% (147) of these students were minority students.




In the fall semester 2011, 14% of UI undergraduate students from the U.S. who reported their ethnicity were minority students.

# Percentage of UI undergraduate students that are minority students




Information on ethnicity was collected from 91% (339) of the graduate and professional students. 24% (82) of these students were minority students.



In the fall semester 2011, 16% of UI graduate & professional students from the U.S. who reported their ethnicity were minorities.


# Percentage of UI graduate & professional students that are minority students


# Percentage of UI undergraduate students that are international students






#### **UI UNDERGRADUATES WHO STUDIED ABROAD**





With a few exceptions, UI students can study abroad on any program which yields credit from an accredited U.S. or foreign university. When UI does not have an established relationship with a program or foreign university, these are referred to as non-UI programs.

In addition, 448 students from other colleges and universities participated in study abroad programs administered by the University of Iowa (83% of those (373) participated in the CIMBA consortial programs administered by the Tippie College of Management). Those 448 students are not included in this report.
