








FIELD OF STUDY & PARTICIPATION RATES

Comparing the number of undergraduate degree candidates who studied abroad during 2012-13 (934) to the number of bachelor's degrees awarded by the UI during 2012-13 (4,562) indicates that approximately 20% of the current graduating class studied abroad during their stay at the UI.

Percentage of UI undergraduate students that are female



In the fall semester 2012, 58% of all UI graduate and professional students were female.


Percentage of UI grad & professional students that are female






ETHNICITY

Information on ethnicity was reported by 95% (851) of the undergraduate U.S. student participants. 15% (125) of these students were minority students.

Percentage of UI undergraduate students that are minority students




4% (37) of the undergraduates who studied abroad were international students studying in a country other than their home country.

Percentage of UI undergraduate students that are international students




Information on ethnicity was collected from 91% (376) of the graduate and professional students. 16% (60) of these students were minority students.



In the fall semester 2012, 16% of UI graduate & professional students from the U.S. who reported their ethnicity were minorities.


Percentage of UI graduate & professional students that are minority students




6% (25) of the graduate and professional students who studied abroad were international students studying in a country other than their home country.

GPA



The average cumulative GPA of UI undergraduates who studied abroad was 3.25. The average cumulative GPA of all UI students was 2.98 for fall 2012.



With a few exceptions, UI students can study abroad on any program which yields credit from an accredited U.S. or foreign university. When the UI does not have an established relationship with a program or foreign university, these are referred to as non-UI programs.

In addition, 421 students from other colleges and universities participated in study abroad programs administered by the University of Iowa. 92% of those, 389, participated in the CIMBA consortial programs administered by the Tippie College of Management. Those 421 students are not included in this report.
