

## Lakha Khan, sarangi, Dane Khan, dholak

Lakha Khan of the desert village of Raneri, Jodhpur District, Rajasthan, is an acclaimed maestro of the folk *sarangi*, an upright bowed lute known for its soul-stirring sound. He belongs to the Manganiyar community, which is both Hindu and Muslim in practice and has for centuries excelled in Rajasthani traditional and Sufi mystical music, bridging the gap between classical and folk. Lakha sings in Hindi, Sindhi, Marwari, and Punjabi, and will be accompanied by his son Dane Khan on *dholak* (double-headed drum). A translator will introduce and explain the songs.
